Season Training:- TBC from Council. But looking at from Tuesday 2nd April, ELS Hall #2 field is the ground that the Club hires for training on Tuesday evening from 8-10pm, Wednesday, Thursdays and Fridays from 4.30pm – 10pm. Tuesdays we have asked for access again to ELS Hall #1 field (synthetic field.)

Pre Season Training:- at our home ground (ELS Hall #2) is not available as baseball ends their season.

All players MUST WEAR shin pads at every training session, pre season or during season.

Boots are permitted on ELS Hall #1, not at any other venue under Council regulations.
